Sherman Hostetter, Jr., CAI, AARE, BAS, CES, GPPA, Named 74th NAA President

Sherman Hostetter, Hostetter Auctioneers, Beaver, Pennsylvania, will serve as the National Auctioneer Association's President for 2022-2023.

Overland Park, Kansas (July 31, 2022) – After one year as National Auctioneer Association (NAA) Vice President, Sherman Hostetter, Jr., CAI, AARE, BAS, CES, GPP, of Beaver, Pennsylvania, took office as NAA President. Sherman was unanimously elected by members at the 2022 Annual Meeting of the National Auctioneers Association.

"I love this profession. My parents started our auction company in 1955, so I was raised in the auction business," Hostetter said. "I am where I am because of the NAA and its members. I feel an obligation to serve and give back to the association that has provided for my family for three going on four generations."

Sherman has served the NAA in various capacities including as a board member of the National Auctioneers Foundation, three times a board member of the National Auctioneers Association, past Chairman of the Education Institute, and a board member of the National Association of Realtors Auction Committee.

In 1992 Hostetter won the Pennsylvania Auctioneers Association Bid Calling Championship and in 2010 won the West Virginia Auctioneers Association Bid Calling Championship. In 2013 Sherman was inducted into the Pennsylvania Auctioneers Association Hall of Fame and in 2015 he was inducted into the National Auctioneers Association Hall of Fame. In 2017 Sherman was inducted into the Beaver County Sports Hall of Fame for his accomplishments in golf during his years of junior golf, high school and college golf and 5 years as a professional golfer.

In addition to his service within the auction industry, Hostetter is also devoted to his community and has been recognized for volunteering within his church, as past school board director for the Blackhawk School District, and has served on numerous boards and committees in the Beaver County area.

Hostetter will serve as president until July 2023, when the next president will take office at the 74th International Conference & Show in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.
